STEEP DRIVEWAY? THEN INSERT A ROLLER ON YOUR HITCH.

If your driveway, like mine is a 1-in-5 incline,
Then one way to stop your tow-ball/hitch from bottoming
out, is to insert a compressed nylon roller into the base of
your hitch.









Further tip: To extend the life of your new 'roller' lay a nylon/plastic (say 5mm thick) MAT across your drive at the point of impact. You can use the mat at your campsite too!
